Since there isn't a creek within 100 miles we just set up on an old dry wash bank! So, we're kind of like the Howling Wolf Saloon, but a lot smaller and we are only play in Crumville!

These saloons grew right along with the west. Soon there were dancing girls, a piano player, plenty of tables and chairs, lots of gambling and don't forget the occasional gun fight or two.

The Yelping Coyote Saloon is an Old West style saloon, but located in a Dance Hall tent like many of the saloons of the Old West were. Yes, the Dance Hall has a dance floor; the music is country of course, but with a few *oldies but goodies* thrown in for good measure. There may be organized gambling with Texas Hold 'em tournaments on Thursday and Friday nights. And if you so desire, you can become an instant star with the Cowboy Karaoke featured Thursday and Friday nights.

The Federalizes don't allow The Yelping Coyote Saloon to sell food or beverages, so we only allow event shooters and their guests to participate. You can buy into the outfit for the three days you are in town (Thursday, Friday and Saturday) and become a co-proprietor for \$20.00 prior to October 23, 2010; price goes up to \$25.00 thereafter. Proprietors are entitled access to the saloon, located within the Gambling and Dance Hall, to enjoy adult beverages including well drinks, ice cold beer, and a wine bar. To everyone's delete will be making the famous Fullmoon 5-Fingers Margarita. We'll be serving 'Well Drinks', but no other fancy drinks. We are Cowboys you know. Non adult beverages such as diet and regular soda and of course, “Sarsaparilla” can be had for only \$10.00 for the three days. And YES, that is the full price for all 3-days!

You'll find no better value west of the Slates, north of the El Paso's, east of the Sierras or south of Inyokern Road!

Anyone in town can come into the Dance Hall to sit around and talk and listen to good music, but to get into the saloon you need to have your event badge.

And remember, no guns allowed after 5PM
