The SASS 2012 California State Black Powder Shootout at *Defend the Roost* and the *Smokeless Powder Resurrection* May 17 – 20, 2012

Well, that was a mouthful, but it all pretty much needs to be in there to describe what we're doing. The October time frame that we slipped *DTR* into this year was a one-time shot. RRBAR had moved the Western Regional to November to coincide with Roy Rogers' birthday, and they've already announced that next year they're going back to October. Since we're all gunshy about November, we're rolling *DTR*, *Resurrection*, and the State BP Shootout into one match, and doing it in May.

The match will be run the way we've done *Resurrection* and the BP Shootout in the past. Poses will have both BP and smokeless shooters, but the BP and smokeless matches will be scored separately. We'll have all the *DTR* trappings—including the tent, lunches, pot lucks, vendors, awards banquet on the range, the Yelping Coyote, and side matches galore, including The Great Train Robbery and The Professionals, which we used to call Wild Bunch, but can't anymore because of confusion regarding the SASS sanctioned side match called Wild Bunch.

We're going to upgrade the awards for first place in all categories, both BP and smokeless, and we'll present the Skeeter Oly Perpetual Clean Shoot Trophy.

We will only be putting on one annual match this year, and this is it, so we're pulling out all the stops. Every year we ask you to sign up early for *Defend the Roost*, and this time is no exception, although there's maybe a little more urgency attached due to the compressed time frame. 
Bad Bascomb won the Speed Shotgun – 87 side match, and Venomous Doc came in first in Speed Derringer.

Congratulations to one and all. You guys and gals done us proud!



Annual membership dues for the RRV are: single membership \$25, member and spouse \$30, family membership (including children under 18 living at home) \$35. First time shooters will be able to take their **FIRST (1) NEW SHOOTERS CLASS** for \$10, any subsequent new shooters class or RRV match shoot will be \$10 members, \$15 non members. Donations for shooting regular monthly RRV matches will be \$10 members, \$15 non-members. Memberships run from September 1 August 31. New memberships purchased after September will be prorated depending on the number of months remaining and the type of membership. SASS first year single initiation membership is \$55, renewal for single membership is \$45.
