
CCRKBA Takes China's Hypocrisy to Task

When the People's Republic of China accused the United States of violating human rights because of our Second Amendment, they voluntarily became the world's laughing stock, according to the Citizens Committee for the Right to Keep and Bear Arms. How soon China must forget the actions of their Government against their own citizens. Lucky for them we have an anniversary to remind people of; June 4, 1989. Just 23 years ago their army sent tanks to Tiananmen Square to discipline their own people.

China's State Council Information Office in Beijing criticized the United States' human rights record because of this country's high level of firearms ownership. In their report, the Chinese alleged, "The United States prioritizes the right to keep and bear arms over the protection of citizens' lives and personal security and exercises lax firearm possession control, causing rampant gun ownership."

The Chinese have hardly set a sterling example for protecting and advancing human rights. Perhaps what offends them most is that our Second Amendment was authored to prevent this country from going down the same road toward totalitarianism that rulers in the People's Republic have embraced. We are not like China, and we will never be like China so long as American citizens retain their right to keep and bear arms, and they know it.

First time shooters will be able to take their FIRST (1) NEW SHOOTERS CLASS for \$10, any subsequent new shooters class or RRV match shoot will be \$10 members, \$15 non members. Donations for shooting regular monthly RRV matches will be \$10 members, \$15 non-members. Memberships run from September 1 - August 31. New memberships purchased after September will be prorated depending on the number of months remaining and the type of membership.
